Jeneica Keeler of Douglas County called 9-1-1 when her grandmother complained of chest pains. She was able to relay pertinent information to the dispatchers. Katherine Liggett also of Douglas County called 9-1-1 when her mother had a seizure. Not attending, but heroes none the less, were 9 year-old Spencer Mittleman of Boulder County, who called 9-1-1 when his mother fell down a flight of stairs and was unconscious, and Lena Barker of Routt County who called 9-1-1 when her brother became trapped head first in deep snow with an obstructed airway while trying to practice a ski jump. All five were awarded certificates, medals, a \$50 gift certificate, teddy bears donated by the Douglas and JeffCo Sheriff's Offices and autographed photos and helmets from the Denver Broncos.
